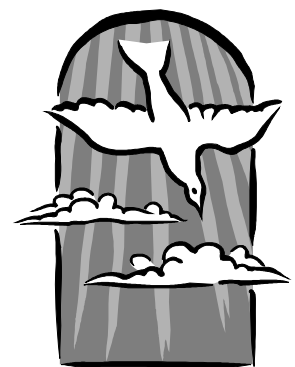
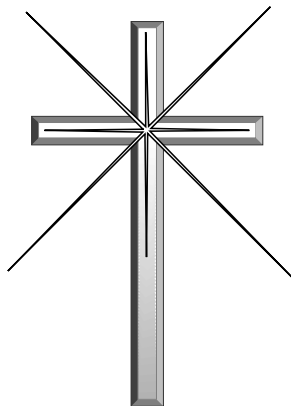
WHY ATTEND THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION?

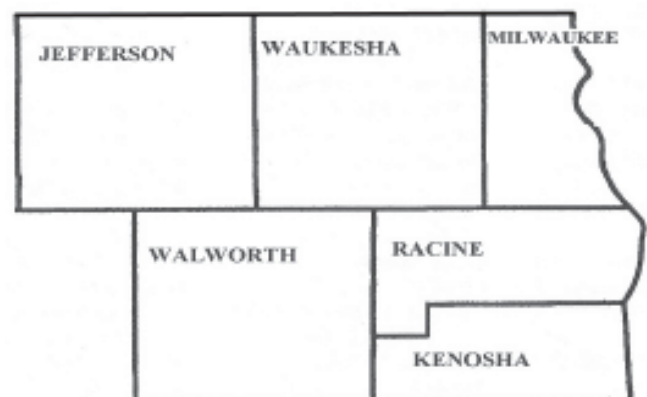

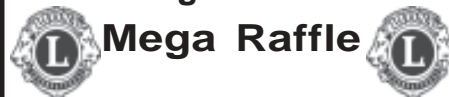
