The annual Lions State Bowling Tournament shall be conducted on a Tournament handicap basis. Each bowler shall receive a handicap of 75% of the difference between his/her average and 220 pins in each event entered not to exceed a maximum of 175 pins per person per event. The handicap allowed shall be taken from the ABC/WIBC handicap manual. Each bowler shall use his/her previous year's highest sanctioned average attained in any league in which 21 games or more were bowled. If he/she does not have a previous year's average, bowler may use highest current sanctioned average as of January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2005 provided 21 games or more have been bowled. If you have no sanctioned average and you have bowled in the State Lions Bowling Tournament in the past 3 years with a minimum of 9 games, you will use the Lions tournament average. If no previous year's or current year's average, men will be required to use an average of 150 pins and women will be required to use 140 pins. The team captain shall verify averages. Failure to use the proper average or to make corrections in averages prior to the completion of the first game shall disqualify score(s). If submitted average is lower than actual average or base prize winnings on submitted average, if it is higher (ABC/WIBC Rule 319a-3), ABC/WIBC Rule 319a-2 and 319d apply with regard to reporting of tournament prize winning and the fifteen-pin reference. Bowlers must be familiar with the re-rating requirements of ABC/WIBC Rule 319e. ABC/WIBC Rule 317 is at the discretion of the host club. All prize money will be returned 100% in the event entered on a handicap basis. The champions in each event shall be declared by actual pin fall plus handicap and will receive appropriate recognition. Prize ratio will be a minimum of 1:10. Team Captains, upon signing this entry form, certify that the bowlers names shown on this form are Wisconsin State Lions/Lioness/Leos for whom competition in this tournament is restricted to. All non-members of ABC or WIBC who are eligible for membership may obtain high score protection by paying affiliate membership dues of \$16.00(ABC) or \$25.00(WIBC). To be eligible to bowl, a bowler must have a Lions Club International Membership I.D. Number. Give name in full for each event. The word "reserved" or "partner" is unacceptable. Order listed is order bowled. Reserve entries close January 5, 2005. Surcharge of \$1.00 per event per bowler for any entry after January 5, 2005 provided lanes are available. In order to bowl in this tournament or any other future State Lions/Lioness/Leos Tournament, bowlers must be in good standing and dues paid up. The host club has responsibility to provide substitutions for any club with a shortage of bowlers in Team or Doubles events. Singles shall be forfeited. Lions State tournament Rules Sect IX, under no circumstances, after entries have been received and filed by the secretary, shall fees be refunded.

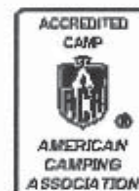

Palmyra Lions Club donates \$2,859 to Palmyra-Eagle Area Athletes Special Olympics.

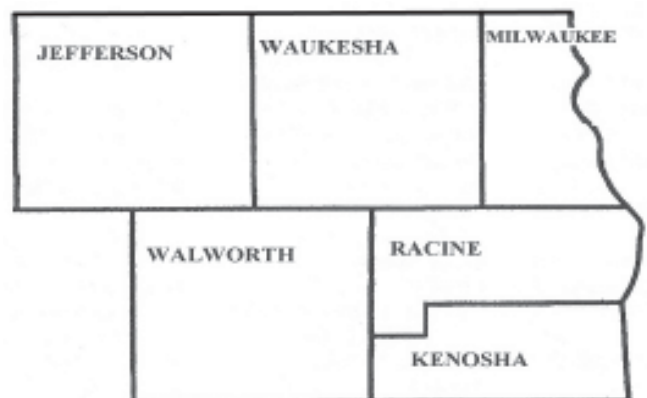

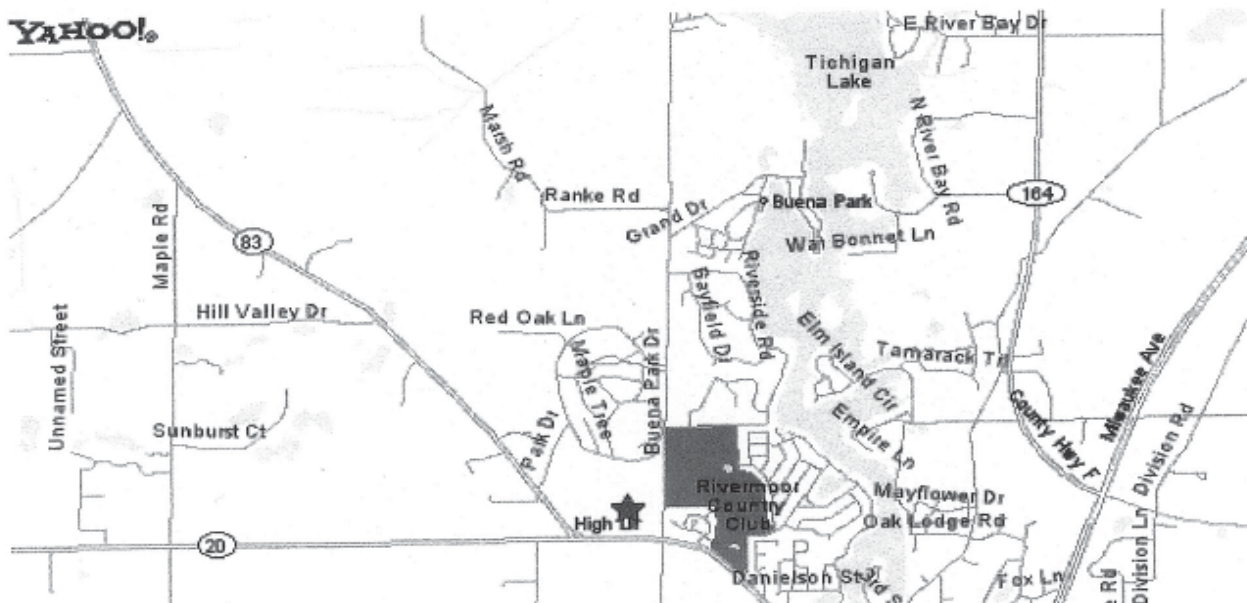
