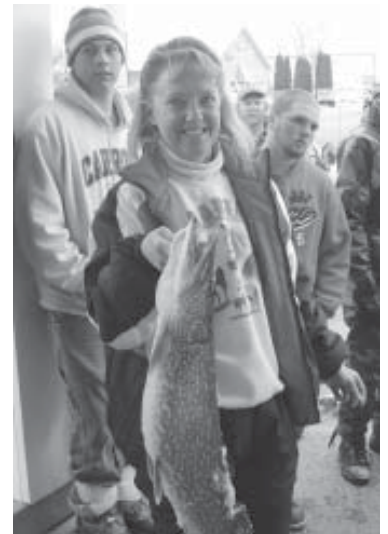
Lake Mills Lions Club
