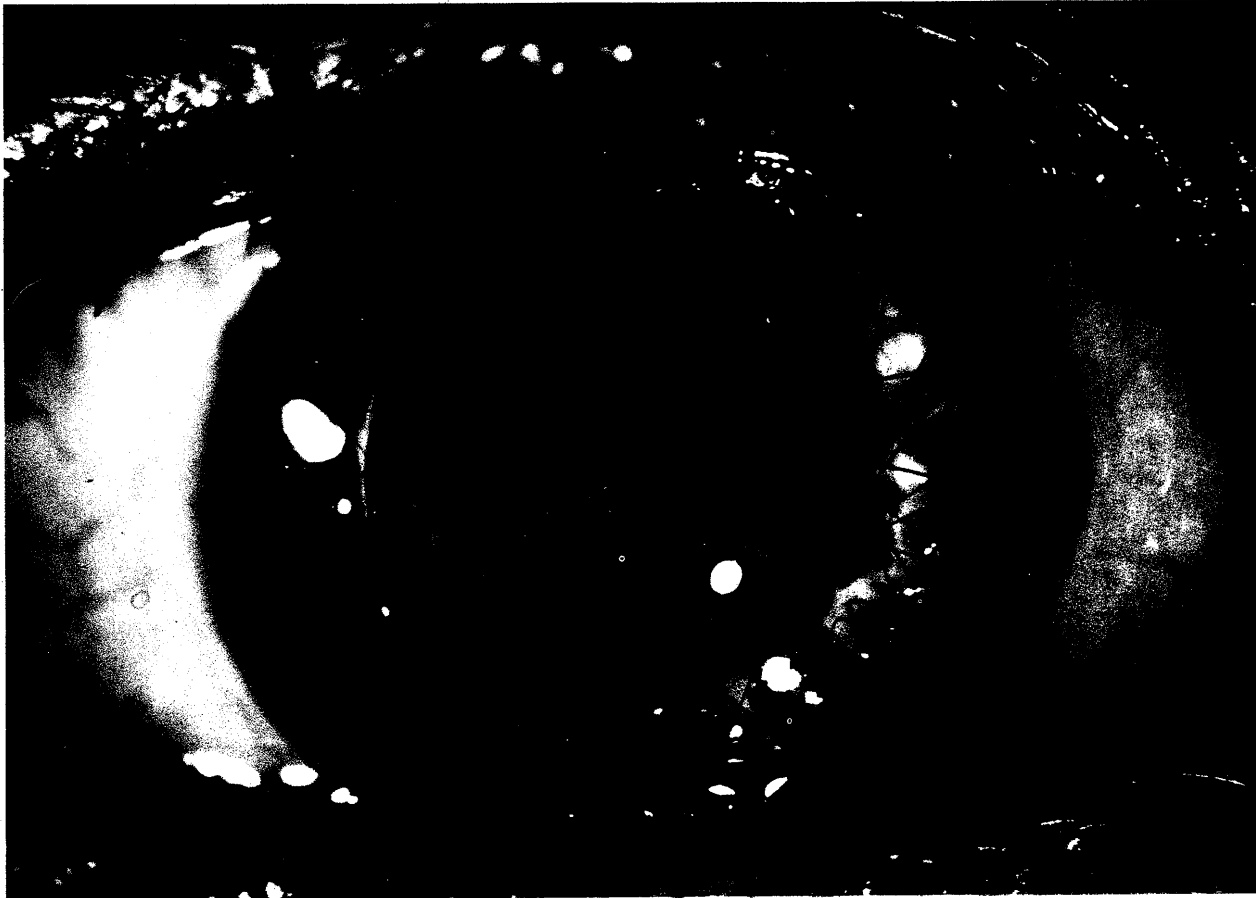

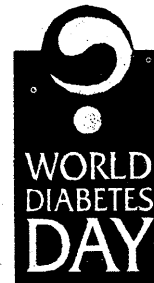

## Your Eyes and Diabetes

### True or False ?



#### How much do you know about diabetic eye complications?

Do you know that one in ten people with diabetes is at risk of developing some severe visual impairment? If you have diabetes, do you know how to reduce your risks of visual loss? Here is a quiz to test your knowledge about your eyes and diabetes.

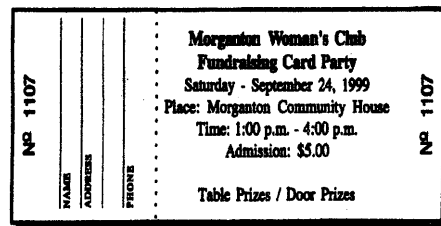

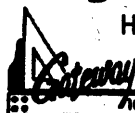
