In 1894, the Fowle Family purchased the land that is now Grant Park & built the Clubhouse shortly thereafter. Milwaukee County bought the land in 1910 employing the gifted arborist & horticulturist Frederick Wulff, whose work included developing a nursery, orchard and greenhouse, as well as planning the Seven Bridges Trail.

Grant Park is part of the Yellowstone Trail, is the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest county park in WI and has the most wildflowers & the highest bluffs on the western shore of Lake Michigan.
